Small Business

- Small Business Committee—This committee works to develop programs and services of benefit to the smaller business members of the Chamber through the presentation of seminars throughout the year and during Business Development Month.

Community Development

- Education & Workforce Development Committee—Works to develop and implement projects to enhance our local educational systems, including the Teacher of the Year awards and the Business and Education Serving Together (BEST) Partnership program.

Convention & Visitors Bureau

- Advisory Committee—This group provides input into the marketing process of attracting tourists and conventions to the Ocoee Region.

Economic Development

- Existing Industry Committee—Members of this committee visit at least one CEO of an existing industry each quarter and attend a monthly committee meeting. They host appreciation activities and promote the program of the Economic Development Council.
- Quality Council Steering Committee—This committee plans and implements quality-focused meetings in conjunction with the Chattanooga Chapter of the American Society for Quality Control.

Membership Development

- Communications—This group works with the Chamber staff to constantly improve and increase communications with members through the media and publications.
- Ambassadors—Ambassadors serve as hosts at Chamber events, visit new members and attend ribbon cuttings and ground breakings.
- Recruitment—Help the Chamber recruit new members during concentrated annual campaign.
- Golf Outing—Help plan and promote the annual membership golf outing.
- Young Professionals Association—This group plans events and programs for young professionals ages 21-35.

- The public affairs committee develops policy recommendations on issues affecting members and coordinates legislative forums for our members.
